



**GRADUATE STUDENT  
TERMS OF PROBATION**

A student must remain in good standing during the entire enrollment in graduate studies at the university. Good standing includes maintaining a minimum 3.0 cumulative graduate GPA, satisfying any program-specific requirements for good standing, and making satisfactory progress towards degree. Students who fail to be in good standing will be placed on probation or dismissed from graduate studies at the university.

**Instructions:**

- \* **Students not in good standing are either placed on probation or dismissed. If you are dismissing a student from the program, complete the dismissal form, not the probation form.**
- \* **Graduate coordinator must complete and sign the probation form by the beginning of the semester after which failure of said student to be in academic good standing occurs.**
- \* **The department/school will provide benchmarks which the student must meet while on probation; benchmarks will be reviewed at the end of each semester or as appropriate. A student who fails to meet the benchmarks or fails to return to good standing by the end of the probationary period may be dismissed by the department/school.**
- \* **Terms of probation are set by the program and do not require the student's input or agreement. If you have not met with the student by the time this form is due, send the completed form to grad.degree.audit@ilstu.edu without the student's signature and send the student a copy.**
- \* **Students who are "Subject to Dismissal" (SBDS) in Campus Solutions will be reviewed by the Graduate School and a decision made on dismissal by the department/school.**
