Current language in Graduate Catalog as 1 of 5 options for MA: Students whose native language is not English may, with departmental or school approval, petition the Graduate School to substitute proficiency in the English language as fulfillment of the language requirement. Proficiency is met by achieving the university minimum total score on TOEFL or IELTS exams.

- 1. University minimum is 105 for Duolingo
- 2. AE program and pathway students complete Academic English courses Suggested updated language

Students whose native language is not English may, with departmental or school approval, petition the Graduate School to substitute proficiency in the English language as fulfillment of the language requirement. Proficiency is met by achieving the university minimum total score on TOEFL, IELTS, or Duolingo exams. Academic English Program/Pathway students who have completed Illinois State Academic English Level 5 would also qualify.

***Option 3 is for English to count as a foreign language for non-English speakers. Option 1 and 2 are for a foreign language to be used that is not English.
