Approval of Minutes

Kim Astroth moved to approve minutes of April 25, 2022. Tom Hammond seconded. All approved.

Welcome and Introductions

Members of the Council and Graduate School were welcomed and introduced themselves.

Administrative report

- a. 10th Day Enrollment
 - i. Rachel Caracci provided enrollment figures. Current graduate total 2,633, last year 2,554, two years ago 2,700.
 - ii. Ten students have withdrawn from the University at this time. Last year total was 14.
 - iii. Total international undergraduate and graduate student enrollment largest in ISU history (330 total 90% graduate).
- b. Marketing and Recruitment initiatives
 - New application services for graduate admissions GradCAS and BusinessCAS to open on October 1 for summer and fall 2023 admissions. Third party service. No cost to university unless a waiver is provided. Application fees: \$63 for GradCAS, \$83 for BusinessCAS.
 - ii. Graduate School staff working closely with graduate coordinators on recruitment. Also staffing table at Bone Student Center (new) and offering virtual sessions.

Committee Reports

- a. Membership/Student Development
 - i. Committee members met after meeting to select a chair. May Jadallah was selected as chair and Rick Nagorski as co-chair.
- b. Curriculum
 - i. September curriculum report submitted. Kim Astroth moved to approve. Tom Hammond seconded. Motion passed with 2 abstentions.
 - ii. Jeff Wagman was selected as chair before committee's first meeting.
- c. Research
 - Committee members met after meeting to select a chair. Shawn Hitchcock was selected as committee chair.

Old Business

- a. Graduate Curriculum Committee Updated Bylaws
 - i. Under review by Rules committee of Academic Senate.
- b. Graduate School Strategic Plan Writing Process
 - i. Draft ready in mid-October.

New Business

- a. Add Duolingo and AE/Pathway to proficiency options for awarding MA.
 - i. Current language in Graduate Catalog includes 5 options for meeting requirement for MA degree: Under option 3: Students whose native language is not English may, with departmental or school approval, petition Graduate School to substitute proficiency in English language as fulfillment of language requirement. Proficiency is met by achieving university minimum total score on TOEFL or IELTS exams.
 - ii. Add to this option:
 - 1. Minimum Duolingo score of 105
 - 2. AE program and pathway students complete Academic English courses
 - iii. Duolingo test is affordable and widely used, now provides sub scores. Approved by Office of General Counsel for teaching assistants to meet language proficiency.
- b. Suggested updated language for option 3 of Master of Arts Degree Requirements
 - i. Students whose native language is not English may, with departmental or school approval, petition the Graduate School to substitute proficiency in the English language as fulfillment of the language requirement. Proficiency is met by achieving the university minimum total score on TOEFL, IELTS, or Duolingo exams. Academic English Program/Pathway students who have completed Illinois State Academic English Level 5 would also qualify.

Council members discussed. Some confusion if this only applies to meeting English language.
